<b>Road Closures (Council Road)</b>	<p>If your event impacts on local traffic access, flows or speed or it be necessary to close any roads or divert any traffic for your event, a Temporary Road Closure Application &amp; Traffic Management Request must be submitted to Council.</p> <p>Fees may apply to non Community events where Council are requested to provide the signage, manpower and traffic management plans.</p> <p>Applications must give sufficient time for processing and a two week notification period to relevant authorities.</p> <p><b>Any application received with less than 30 calendar days before the event will not be approved.</b></p>

- Rule 298** Driving with a person in a trailer - provided the speed of the vehicle does not exceed 25 km/h

- Rule 331** Crossing a road at pedestrian lights
- Rule 237** Getting on or into a moving vehicle – provided the speed of the vehicle does not exceed 5 km/h
- Rule 264** Wearing of seatbelts by drivers – provided the speed of the vehicle does not exceed 25 km/h
- Rule 268** How persons must travel in or on a motor vehicle - provided the speed of the vehicle does not exceed 25 km/h,
