<p>Please provide a description of the regulated Retail Services currently offered, as specified on the Pricing Schedule.</p>	<p>Drinking Water Service supply to residents of Denial Bay and Koonibba and farming properties along mains pipeline. Drinking Water Service supplied to commercial tenants of Smoky Bay Aquaculture Park.</p> <p>Sewerage services (CWMS) supplied to residents within Ceduna, Thevenard &amp; Smoky Bay (septic tank service not full sewer).</p> <p>Recycled Treat waste water supplied to entities within Ceduna, Thevenard &amp; Smoky Bay who have complied with specified requirements of SA Recycled Water Guidelines</p>
<p>Please provide information on how the current pricing policies have been developed.</p>	<p>CWMS Service Charges have been calculated based 50 year Net Present Value Whole of Life models for Ceduna &amp; Smoky Bay schemes. To service charge revenue designed to cover ongoing operating costs and future capital refurbishment only. Prices have also been developed to allow for merging of schemes into one unit for 2015-16 Financial Year.</p> <p>Recycled Water usage charged based on additional costs of water treatment to Class B potable water for reuse requirements.</p> <p>Drinking water service charge have been calculated to cover future capital refurbishment of scheme based on 50 year Net Present Value Whole of Life model. Drinking water usage charge designed to cover operating costs of schemes (exc. Depreciation). 2017-18 usage charge based on gradual increase from \$0.30 over SA Water Tier 2 price to full cost recoupment value.</p>
<p>Please describe the rationale for the price movements between the 2017-18 and 2016-17.</p>	<p>Increase in CWMS Service Charge price based on updated 50 year Net Present Value Model and merging of both CWMS schemes into one business model. Drinking Water prices have increased as part of Council's process to a full cost recovery system.</p>
