Draft 2022/2023 Annual Business Plan

New installs at the Ceduna Skate Park, Thevenard Botanical Park and Pinky Point will be next to open.



Ceduna Airport

Works on the exclusion fencing installation and the unsealed runway resurfacing are complete at the Ceduna Airport. Council were successful in their application for funding from the SA Government's Support Regional Aviation Program, to assist with the installation of an animal exclusion fence around the perimeter of the Ceduna Airport.
