## Ceduna Swimming Enclosure Reopened

The Ceduna Safe Swimming Enclosure suffered damage to the net, gangway and floating pontoon following an extreme weather event on Monday 30 May 2022. The 200kg weight securing the position of the floating pontoon moved during the weather event and resulted in the floating pontoon damaging the northern side of the net. On Thursday 2nd of June 2022 divers repositioned the floating pontoon, repaired sections of damaged net and commenced repair on the damaged gangway and entry pontoon. In addition, in situ water blast cleaning of the net was undertaken, to avoid the need to remove the net for cleaning. The enclosure was reopened to the public Friday 10 June.
