Council Projects

Council has been successful in securing funding to construct 8 new public toilet facilities throughout the region. The existing facilities located at Foster's Boat Ramp, Council carpark on O'Loughlin Tce, Cockleshell Park, Denton Street Playground Smoky Bay, and Denial Bay Foreshore amenities will be replaced and 3 new facilities at Ceduna Skate Park, Pinky Point Lookout and Hambidge St Park will be constructed.

Council will be distributing a tourism stakeholder engagement survey in the first week of October. These results will help to develop the regions tourism strategy for 2022-2025.

Projects completed during the month of August

- Light installation Smoky Bay boat ramp
- Smoky Bay walking trail rolled
- 3.5km re-sheeting of Nielsens Road
- 4.2km re-sheeting Oorla Tank Rd

Council has confirmed it's intent to reapply for a Coastal Protection grant in 2021 after an unsuccessful bid in 2020 to secure funding toward the costs of the Smoky Bay revetment wall. If successful the revetment wall is proposed to be constructed on the council controlled section of land between South Tce and Tremaine St.
