### **Council Projects**

Council are currently undertaking works to install new solar lighting at the Denial Bay Jetty. The Denial Bay Jetty is currently closed to the public and is estimated to reopen Friday 5 November 2021. The projects total cost for the supply and installation of solar lights on the Denial Bay Jetty is \$86,604 excluding GST.

The Ceduna swimming enclosure, floating pontoon and nets have been reinstalled this week following winter maintenance and is now open for public use. Council have received designs for a larger fixed platform to replace the floating entry platform at the Ceduna swimming enclosure.

Once Council has reviewed the design and confirmed cost estimates, grant funding will be pursued to progress this upgrade to the swimming enclosure.

Dethatching of Ceduna Foreshore lawns will commence over the next few weeks to improve the health and amenity of the lawn. The lawn areas will look brown for some weeks following the process. Spring is the appropriate time to undertake the works and the lawns will recover quickly.
