Inclusive Special Education Hub & Community Library

The Community was clearly concerned with the news that the School Community Library would have to close due to the School requiring the building for the expanding of the Special Education Classroom.

Blair Boyer MP, Minister for Education, Training & Skills has announced \$4.5 million of funding for a new facility specifically designed for students with special needs, freeing the library building for use by the wider community.

Property Vehicle Crossing Place

Residents and Business Owners may not be aware that it is the legal responsibility of property owners to establish and maintain 'Vehicle Crossing Places' - that is the section of their driveway from the sealed or formed road and their property entrance.

Vehicle Crossing Places can be simply soil or gravel, as long as it is fit for purpose, but if a more permanent construction such as concrete, asphalt or pavers is desired, approval from Council is required prior to construction.
