## Local Government Elections VOTE

Candidate profiles are now available to view on the Electoral Commission of SA (ECSA) website.

Voting in Council elections is conducted by post. All election materials, including ballot papers, are mailed directly to the postal address you provided on the electoral roll.

The mailout of ballot packs occurs from 14 October to 20 October 2022.

Close of voting is 5:00pm on Thursday 10 November 2022.

Note: Ballot papers are to be received at the Council Office or ECSA by the close of voting.

## Property Maintenance

Council has commenced issuing of reminder notices to property owners to mow/slash or create sufficient firebreaks around their property for the upcoming fire danger season.

Subsequent property inspections will be conducted from 10 Oct 22. Due to the late seasonal rains the district has experienced, property owners should be mindful vegetation will continue to grow at rapid rates for the foreseeable future and that property owners may need to have blocks mowed/slashed several times to limit risks to neighbouring properties.

Following the inspection expiations and Section 105F notices will be issued to property owners who have not completed the required mowing or slashing.
